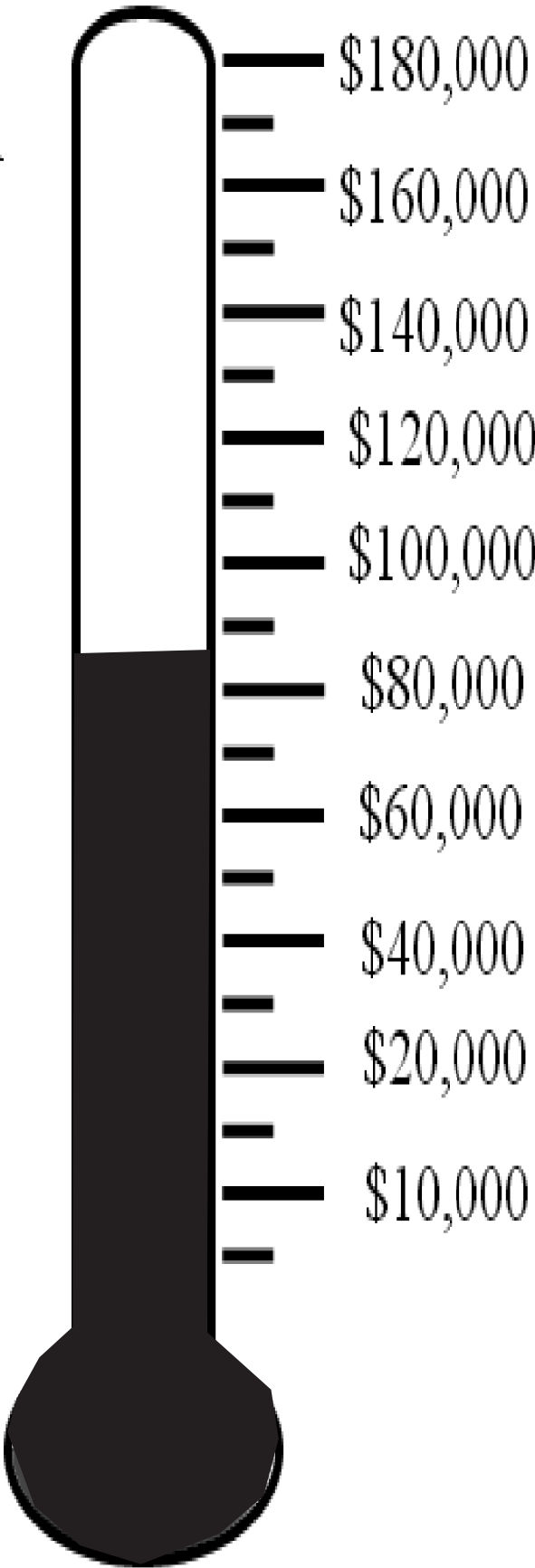

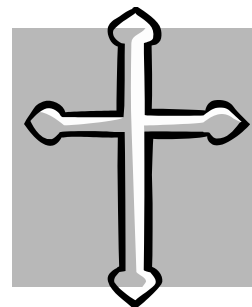

**Day 3:** Food Treasure Hunt: You will be guided through the traditional food markets of Thessaloniki to meet and greet the local food dealers, collect recipe ingredients from a list with the help of a map, and bring them back to the hotel for a Greek cooking tutorial under the Chef's guidance. After the end, you will taste the food you cooked and will be given a complimentary Greek cookbook. (B,D)

**Day 4:** Day trip to the ancient town of Philippi. We will visit the site where Paul was jailed upon his arrival to Macedonia, as well as the roads he walked in the town and the places he visited. After the main site of Philippi, we will visit the small stream outside the city where Paul baptized Lydia. We will then make our way to the modern city of Kavala, which used to be called Neapolis. This is the port where Paul arrived from his journey from Troas. Kavala is still a port today and we will have lunch at a local restaurant. On our return journey to Thessaloniki, we will make a stop at the ancient city of Amphipolis. (B,D)

**Day 5:** We will visit the nearby town of Ouranopolis. There we will embark on a three-hour cruise along the coast of the Holy Mountain. We will see the 15-centuryold monasteries and learn all about the history, culture and life style in the monastic peninsula from our guide. (B,D)

**Day 6:** Visit the ancient royal Macedonian tombs of Vergina before going to Veroia. We will have time for lunch in the city of Veroia followed by a visit to the ancient site of Dion, the port from which Apostle Paul took the boat to go to Athens. (B,D)

**Day 7:** We will visit Thessaloniki city center to see the major historical sites related to Apostle Paul, the House of Jason, the Roman Agora and the old town and castles. We will also have the chance to visit Thessaloniki's most famous landmark, the White Tower. (B,D)

**Day 8:** Departure for Istanbul. Guided tour of Byzantine Relics. Visit of the Patriarchate of Constantinople, Chora Church and Blachernae. Settled at a luxury 4+ hotel in the center. (B,D)

**Day 9:** Full Day Old City Istanbul. Visit the Hippodrome, Aghia Sophia, the Top Capi Palace, the Blue Mosque and Grande Bazar. (B,L)

**Day 10:** Princess Island Tour: A full day tour of Chalki and Prince Island. (B,L)

**Day 11:** Departure for Boston

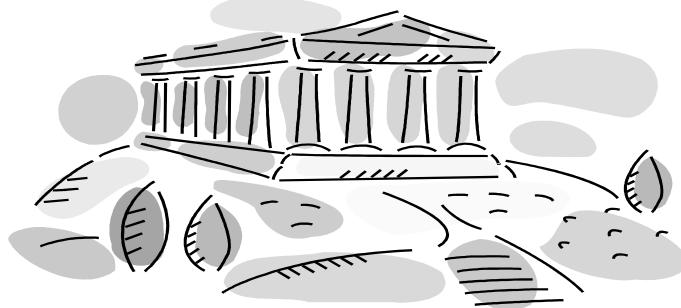
