## A FOND FAREWELL

*("To everything there is a season")*

August 20, 2005 I began my pastoral ministry to the Saint George Cathedral family. I remember my first sacrament as pastor was to bless the marriage of Bill and Toula Barber. The next day I celebrated my first Divine Liturgy as pastor, although I had already served two Sundays the beginning of that month as part of my "interview" process.

I begin my tenth year the 21st of next month. I will be retiring the end of August and I will be serving my last Divine Liturgy as pastor, here at Saint George on Sunday, August 24th. That very same day I will begin my road trip to the Northwest. I plan to settle in the Seattle, Washington area. It will be in the same time zone as my daughters and their families and just a three hour highway drive from them. We are all excited by the opportunities to spend more time together.

I have served here longer than any other parish. It has been a rewarding ministry and I have truly enjoyed working with you. I have served with several Presidents and their respective boards. Those presidents were: George Copadis, Frank Comerford, John Mokas, Dick Anagnost, Nikki Moutsioulis, (who also served as Sunday school supervisor for several years when we were in need of someone with experience) and Richard Boisvert.

Many of the experiences here at Saint George have been pleasant and rewarding. As in all relationships, there were times of frustration and disappointment on my part and, I am sure, on the part of some of you who are affiliated with Saint George Cathedral. This was, I am sure, the direct result of our personal imperfections and independent mindedness. Most of us, however, weathered the various storms in this relationship because of our love for God and His church here in Manchester.

I am truly blessed to have felt absolutely at home as part of the Saint George parish family from the very beginning. YOU have made that possible by your welcoming and caring spirit.....so welcoming and caring that I put on 55 pounds during my first four years.

This was my first assignment without my Presvytera, who passed in 2003. I guess some felt I needed to be kept in unbelievably great tasting food and fresh baked bread. I do cook, but naturally I ate EVERYTHING given to me. Thus, the unbelievable weight gain. (So easy to pack on but not so easy to lose.) I am not, however, complaining, just some information I thought you might enjoy. A special "thank you" to Athena Dalber, Popi (Kyria Despina) Tsoutsas, Marie MacArthur, Cathy Moufarge, the Paul O'Briens and Jeff and Kelly Hebert, Joyce Bourque (Shepherds Pie), Nancy Daskal (homemade marmalade), and a host of others who made it possible for me to maintain my "plumpness".

There were several who made the prosforo on a regular basis, including, Kelly Urban, Jayne O'Connor, Popi Tsoutsas, Athena Dalber, Sultana Mokas, Daphne Lalopoulos, and Marie MacArthur. We thank each and everyone who did this for the divine services.

I thank Mark Adam, Nola Kalantzis, and all who helped me at chanting during the divine services, along with all my beautiful choir members, under the able direction of Cathy Moufarge accompanied on the organ by Joyce Trapotsis (Kyria Georgia).

Thank you also to Athena Moutsioulis Bevan who assumed the reigns of the Sunday School after Nikki was elected to the Board of Directors and then President (the first woman in the history of the parish). The two of them, along with ALL of the dedicated teachers, without whose efforts and dedication there would be NO Sunday School.

The Anagennesis Ladies have been and continue to be the go-to group here at Saint George. Their tireless efforts, under the current Presidency of Cathy Moufarge and her dedicated and cohesive board, are a true inspiration and example to all the ladies of the parish. They exemplify the true meaning of volunteerism.

I have truly missed George Demos. He was a very valuable assistant in the divine services and an unbelievable historian of important and unimportant parish history. May our benevolent God grant him a place of true rest and peace where all the pain, sorrow and sighing of this world are gone. May he join the other 270 deceased members of Saint

George who have passed during the last 9 years. Thank you also to Dan, our custodian, who has done an admirable job in helping to fill George’s absence by getting the church ready for services and funerals.

When I finish my ministry here, we will have had at least 271 funerals, 140 Baptisms, 13 Chrismations and 42 Weddings.

In 1965, The Birds came out with a song, which music was written by Pete Seeger. It was entitled, **Turn, turn, turn**” and was adapted from Ecclesiastes 3:1, “to everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven:”

This is the season for me to step aside, after 42 years in full time ministry, to allow myself more time to spend with family; enjoy some unencumbered free time for myself and to help other clergy in the Northwest who need someone to help them when their burden gets to be a little overwhelming.

I will always pray for the Saint George parish family. I humbly ask that you keep me in your prayers.

“May the Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Love of God the Father, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you” as you continue to seek and share God’s Love and Peace.



## DORMITION OF THE THEOTOKOS ON AUGUST 15TH

***MANY OF US KNOW THAT THERE IS A FEAST,  
BUT FEW OF US KNOW THE BACKGROUND.  
SO, HERE IT IS.***

### INTRODUCTION

The Feast of the Dormition of Our Most Holy Lady, the Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary is celebrated on August 15 each year. The Feast commemorates the repose (dormition and in the Greek *kimisis*) or "falling-asleep" of the Mother of Jesus Christ, our Lord. The Feast also commemorates the translation or assumption into heaven of the body of the Theotokos.

### BIBLICAL STORY

The Holy Scriptures tell us that when our Lord was dying on the Cross, He saw His mother and His disciple John and said to the Virgin Mary, "Woman, behold your son!" and to John, "Behold your mother!" (John 19:25-27). From that hour, the Apostle took care of the Theotokos in his own home. Along with the biblical reference in Acts 1:14 that confirms that the Virgin Mary was with the Holy Apostles on the day of Pentecost, the tradition of the Church holds that she remained in the home of the Apostle John in Jerusalem, continuing a ministry in word and deed. At the time of her death, the disciples of our Lord who were preaching throughout the world returned to Jerusalem to see the Theotokos. Except for the Apostle Thomas, all of them including the Apostle Paul were gathered together at her bedside. At the moment of her death, Jesus Christ himself descended and carried her soul into heaven. Following her repose, the body of the Theotokos was taken in procession and laid in a tomb near the Garden of Gethsemane. When the Apostle Thomas arrived three days after her repose and desired to see her body, the tomb was found to be empty. The bodily assumption of the Theotokos was confirmed by the message of an angel and by her appearance to the Apostles.


