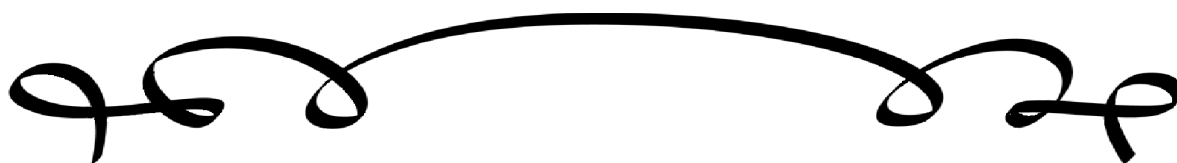

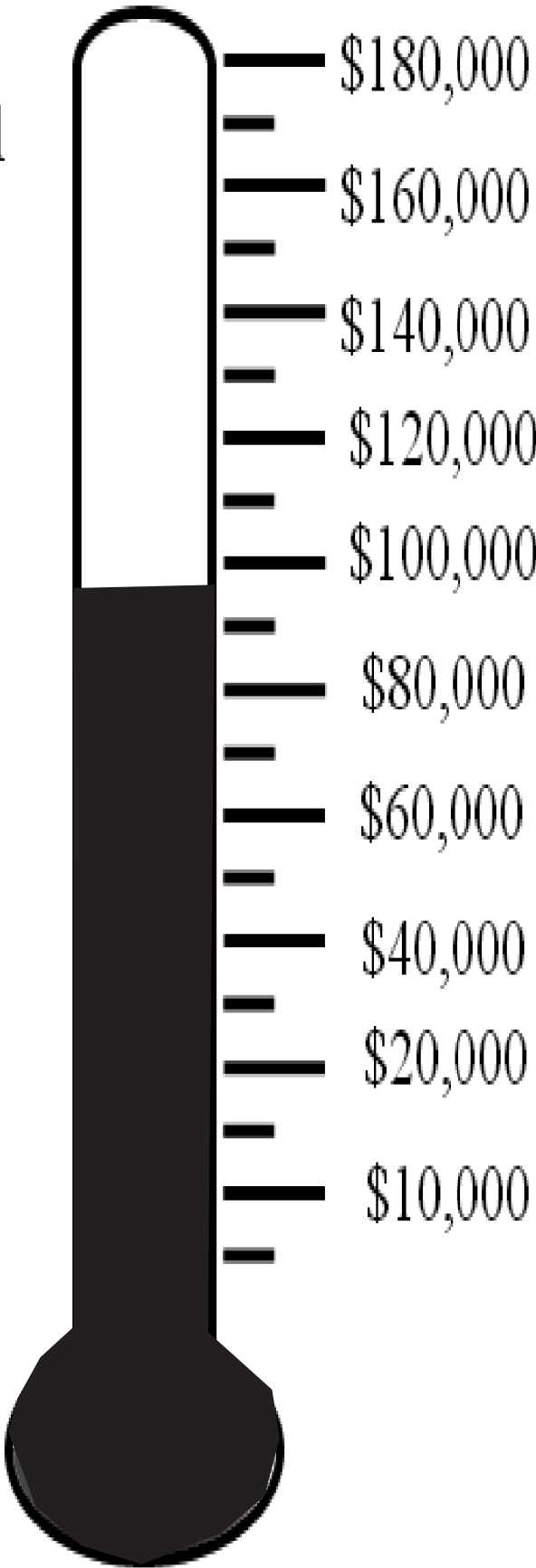

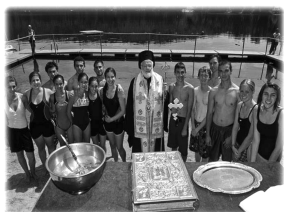
## URGENT NEED FOR FOOD

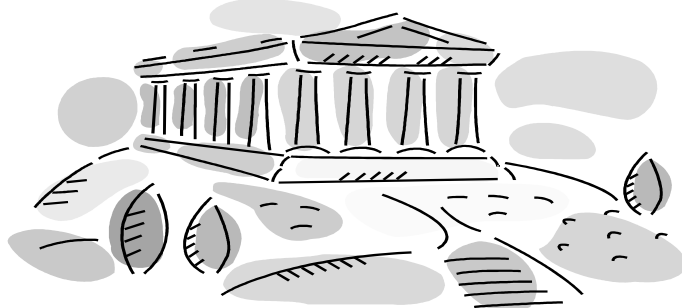
